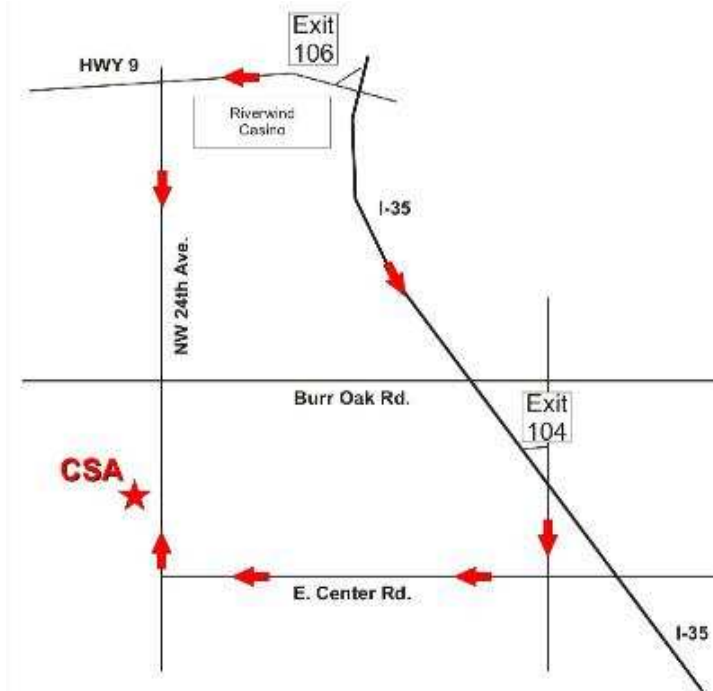

From the North: I-35 to Exit 106 (Hwy. 9 West at Riverwind Casino). Go West one mile toward Chickasha and turn left onto Santa Fe (also known as NW 24th Street) then go South 2.2 miles. The Academy is on the right (West side of the road).

From the West on Hwy. 9, turn right onto Santa Fe (also known as NW 24th Street), and follow the above directions.

From the South: I-35 to Exit 104 (Goldsby), loop back over the Interstate on NW Main (going South over the Interstate). Just past Marcum's Nursery and Libby's Cafe, turn right (West) onto E. Center Road. Continue to NW 24th; turn right onto NW 24th (also known as Santa Fe). The Academy is on the left (West side of the road).

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and are able to perform all obstacles safely.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site.

Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not allowed to use whistles or other instruments or devices.

Flash photography is not permitted except under special circumstances authorized by the club.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Choke collars, pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited at the show.

Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling or misconduct of any kind, will result in excusal from the ring.

Obstacle Familiarization - Obstacle familiarization will be Saturday and Sunday mornings prior to judging for dogs and handlers who have not previously been on the TDAA equipment.

Warm-ups – a warm up area, consisting of at least a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

TDAA uses scaled-down equipment on a proportionally set course. Most obstacles will be on small-dog scale. See <http://www.k9tdaa.com> for details.

Additional Show Site Information

Site is indoors and climate controlled. The courses will be run on custom matted flooring, 3'8" thick, in an approximately 95' x 40' area. The building will be open for crating set up from 6-8 p.m. on Friday. Crating areas are ringside. Please be prepared to stack crates if asked. Ample grassy areas for walking dogs are located outside the building. *Please clean up after your dog.*

Restrooms – Two restrooms are located in the building.

Food - Food will be available for purchase. Volunteers who work two or more shifts each day will receive complimentary lunch.

Eligibility - This trial is open to all dogs 17 inches and under at the withers that are over the age of 12 months, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance.

Standard Classes

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS

In a TDAA standard course the dog is required to run without fault in order to qualify. Faults are assessed for dropping bars, missing (down) contact zones, on & off the table, taking a wrong course, failure to perform an obstacle, and touching or otherwise assisting the dog. Refusals are faulted only on contact obstacles, and only for Intermediate and Superior courses. In Beginners, a 4-paw safety rule will be enforced. If a dog commits to a contact obstacle (4-paws) and then comes off, the handler will be instructed by the judge to skip the obstacle and continue

the sequence of the course. Table performances might be down, sit, or stand... for the judge's count of 5 seconds.

Games Classes

JUDGE'S BRIEFING ON DAY OF TRIAL SUPERSEDES ANY PREVIOUS BRIEFINGS

QUIDDITCH

Briefing:

Each team will have 60 seconds to complete three numbered sequences. When time expires the dog should be directed to the table to stop time. The point values for each of the sequences are 15, 20, and 25 points respectively. Each sequence can be successfully completed only once. The sequences can be taken in any order. Each obstacle has individual point values that are earned by a team if a sequence is only partially completed prior to time expiring.

- 1 point for jumps
- 3 points for tunnels
- 5 points for contact obstacles and weave poles

Upon the successful completion of a sequence the team will have the opportunity to earn bonus points for a successful performance of a tire (the 'Beater' bonus), for which the team will earn an additional 25 points.

For Games II and III to earn the *Beater bonus* the handler must send the dog to the tire from outside of the containment lines indicated on the course-map. For Games I the handler has no such restriction.

Scoring:

Quidditch is scored points then time. The dog with the most points wins. In the case of a tie, the dog with the shortest time will be the winner.

Qualifying:

- Games I – 125 points
- Games II – 125 points
- Games III – 150 points

TOUCH N GO

Briefing:

This course consists of contact obstacles and tunnels only. The handler must direct the dog to perform the obstacles in the order specified by the judge. Refusals are not faulted, and there are no jump bars to drop. All the handler has to worry about is the dog touching the contacts and staying on course.

Scoring:

Touch 'n Go is scored faults then time. The dog with the fewest faults will win. Time is a tiebreaker only.

WEAKEST LINK

Briefing:

The objective of this game is to score as many points as possible in 60 seconds. Only "banked" points will count toward the final score. Points are banked each time the dog takes the banking obstacle (usually a tire or table). Each obstacle taken by the dog must be worth as much or more than the previous obstacle taken; if not they will lose any un-banked points. Each Level will be given 60 seconds to accumulate points. Clock starts when any part of the dog crosses the start line. Clock stops when any part of the dog crosses finish line after the 60 second whistle has blown. If a team wishes to stop the clock prior to the whistle, the dog must cross finish line and handler must tell the timer to stop.

Banked points can never be lost! Each sequence of "banked" points must be unique in some way (reverse order would be fine). If a dog faults, all potential un-banked points are lost. Faults include: *Dropped bars, Missed contacts, Taking an obstacle of lesser value, failing to bank faults before whistle*. When the dog faults the judge will call "fault". The handler is obligated to direct the dog to the first obstacle in a new sequence to begin any points sequence again.

Scoring:

Scored point, then time. Time is a tiebreaker only.

*Jumps - 2 points.

*Tunnels & Tire - 4 points.

*Contacts - 6 points.

*Weaves – 8 points.

Qualifying:

GI = 30 points or more

GII = 40 points or more

GIII = 50 points or more

DARE TO DOUBLE

Briefing:

Dare to Double is a dog's choice game, which means that he will earn points for taking obstacles in the order and direction of his own choosing. The team has 50 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. The game begins at a start line designated by the judge and ends at the table or a designated finish line.

The team must get to the table before course time elapses. If the team gets to the table before time expires, they keep all points accumulated on course. If the team fails to do so, half of the team's points are lost.

The value of scoring obstacles is based on a simple 1-3-5-7 system:

- 1 point for jumps
- 3 points for tunnels and tire
- 5 points for dogwalk and weave poles
- 7 points the teeter

Scoring obstacles can be taken only twice for points. Back-to-back performances are allowed. Jumps that are knocked down will not be reset and will have no subsequent value.

The A-frame has a special value (Note that the A-frame was not included in this list above). It is the doubling obstacle. During the run, a handler may double his current points by performing the doubling obstacle. A successful performance doubles all points earned up to that time. If, however, the dog faults the A-frame, then the dog loses half of his existing points.

A handler may double points any time he wishes, as many times as he wishes. The only restriction on doubling is that the A-frame cannot be performed back-to-back. Thus, the handler must do another obstacle, for points, before attempting to double point values again.

A warning whistle is blown 15 seconds prior to the expiration of time. If the dog does not make it to the table (where time stops) by the end of the Standard Course Time, then the dog will be faulted, losing half of all the points he has accumulated.

Scoring:

Dare to Double is scored points then time. The winner is the dog finishing with the most points. In case of a tie, time is the tiebreaker. The

table is live during the entire run. If the dog gets on the table at any time, scoring ends.

Standard Class

BEGINNER AGILITY— All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

INTERMEDIATE AGILITY — Dogs that have earned the Teacup Beginner Agility Dog (TBAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

SUPERIOR AGILITY — Dogs that have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agility Dog (TIAD) or that have earned the Teacup Superior Agility Dog (TSAD) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

GAMES I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class. There shall be no grandfathering of titles from other organizations.

GAMES II — Only dogs that have earned the Games I (TG1) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

GAMES III — Only dogs that have earned the Games II (TG2) or Games III (TG3) or that have satisfied the appropriate Fast Track requirement shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Provisional dogs must be measured by a judge.

4" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 8" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 12" or less.

8" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 12" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 15" or less.

12" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 15" or less at the withers; or dogs with a jump height exemption measuring 17" or less.

16" jump height – Restricted to dogs measuring 17" or less at the withers.

Jump Height Exemptions:

"Special provisions are made for dogs that are long-backed, have a weight-to-height exemption, or who have dwarfish legs (see rules for complete description of height exemptions; www.k9tdaa.com). A jump height exemption (next lower height) will also be granted to veteran dogs (dogs of at least 7 years of age).

These exemptions are explained in detail at www.k9tdaa.com, click on Rules and go to section 3.4 Jump Heights.

FEO – TDAA now offers FEO (For Exhibition Only) standard runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last in their jump height. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles or certificates. No treats or food allowed in ring.

Entries:

Entries close at 6:00 p.m. July 27, 2009, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms. One dog per entry form.

Photocopied entries without the signed TDAA agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the Trial. Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.

The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 service charge for any returned checks. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or if barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial or on the trial premises.

VOLUNTEER SIGN UP

FAST TRACK MOVE-UP

Titles may be grandfathered from other organizations on a "Fast Track" basis. A dog with a higher title from another organization may move up on the same day to the next level of TDAA competition with a qualifying score. It is possible to move up from Beginners to Superior on the same day, if the dog qualifies first in Beginners, and then on their next run in Intermediate.

Dogs moving up on the Fast Track will not be eligible for placement, titles or ribbons in classes/levels through which they fast-track. A separate entry fee may be required for dogs moving up on the Fast Track. A fee is to be collected only once per dog, for fast tracking in either the games class, the standard class, or both.

I (We) acknowledge that the "Teacup Dogs Agility Association Rules & Regulations" have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (We) agree to hold the TDAA., TDAA approved judge and Canine Sports Academy Agility harmless from any legal claim resulting from said judge's action under the TDAA Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (We) agree that Canine Sports Academy Agility has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged, I (we) agree to hold harmless the directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed.
